09:00-11:00 Visiting Torun – the medieval city of the Nicolaus Copernicus - renaissance mathematician and astronomer who formulated a model of the universe that placed the Sun rather than the Earth at the center of the universe

11:00-12:00 The Living Museum of Ginger Bread (traditional Polish gingerbread that has been produced since the Middle Ages in the city of Torun; here you can learn about every ritual connected with baking gingerbreads)

12:00-13:30 Free time (lunch on your own)

16:30-18:30 Visiting: The Castle of the Teutonic Order in Malbork - classic example of a medieval fortress and, on its completion in 1406, was the world's largest brick castle. UNESCO designated the "Castle of the Teutonic Order in Malbork" and the Malbork Castle Museum a World Heritage Site in December 1997

09:00-12:00 Visiting Gdansk: Gdansk is one of Poland's oldest cities with a history going back a thousand years. It has an important place in Polish consciousness as the location of the start of World War II and where the fall of Communism in Central Europe began. This is where the famous Solidarity movement started, protecting worker's rights and, later, the symbol of resistance against the People's Republic. Together with neighbouring Gdynia and Sopot, Gdansk forms a large metropolitan area called Trójmiasto (Tricity). This is a place not to be missed when

visiting Poland. It is rich in cultural and architectural relics. Visiting: The Old City, St. Mary's Church, Mariacka Street, Długa Street, Artus Court, Amber Museum.
